PARLIAMENT DEBATES THE COMPANY LAW REFORM BILL

This is a unique opportunity to ensure that UK companies do not profit at the expense of people and the environment.

The Trade Justice Movement and Corporate Responsibility (CORE) Coalition – representing charities, human rights, environment and development groups, trade unions and faith groups – are calling for changes in the law to ensure:

- Companies report on their social and environmental impacts.
- Directors take steps to minimise the harm their company may cause to local communities and the environment.
- People overseas who are harmed by a UK company and are denied justice in their own country have the right to take legal action in a UK court.

The British public agree with us. A recent poll showed that 90% of voters think “the Government should set out enforceable rules to ensure companies are socially responsible”.
