

Gift Aid your donations

If you sign up to Gift Aid today you can make your donation worth 28% more – at no cost to yourself.

If you are a UK taxpayer, paying income tax and/or capital gains tax, you can sign up for Gift Aid.

For example, a £10 donation to Traidcraft is worth an extra £2.82 – that we claim direct from the Inland Revenue, making your gifts worth even more to the people we work with in the developing world.

To qualify for Gift Aid, you must pay an amount of UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that Traidcraft Exchange reclaims on your donations in the appropriate tax year (currently 25p for each £1 given). HMRC will also be operating transitional provisions for Gift Aid donations made from 6th April 2008 until 5th April 2011, paying a Government supplement of 3p on every pound you give.
