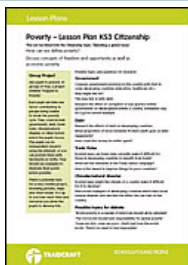
Lesson Plans

Citizenship

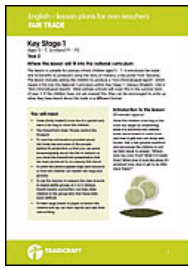


Poverty
